Brae Burn Country Club – Purchase, New York

RBA was hired to assist the Club with the development of a long-range master plan. Proposed improvements include tee leveling and expansion, bunker renovations, pond excavation, drainage and fairway recontouring. Several fairways along with the practice fairway require significant regrading to improve playability, strategy and drainage. Frank Duane originally designed the course in the late 1960's.

Dellwood Country Club – New City, New York

RBA was hired to design and oversee renovations to the bunkers and green surrounds on its 1920's A.W. Tillinghast designed private member course. The Owner is considering the development of a comprehensive Master Plan for the balance of the work.

Edgewood Country Club – River Vale, New Jersey

This private 27-hole club hired RBA in 2006 to redesign hole #2 Green Complex on the Red Course. RBA was recently hired to oversee on-going course improvements.

Elmwood Country Club – White Plains, New York

This private, 18-hole club originally designed by A.W. Tillinghast in 1928 hired The RBA Group to redesign several bunkers, tees and greens on the course. The Club is considering tee and bunker renovations to the remaining holes in the future.

Glen Head Country Club – Glen Head, New York

This private, 18-hole club retained RBA to develop a comprehensive master plan to address renovations to tee and bunker complexes. Historic aerial photography and related drawings are assisting in the development of the plans and the construction work. The Club was originally known as Women's Golf and Tennis Club as developed in 1923 by Marion Hollins and designed by a consortium of Devereux Emmet, Charles Blair Macdonald and Seth Raynor.

Griffith E. Harris Golf Course – Greenwich, Connecticut

RBA was commissioned to develop a master plan to be implemented over 4-6 years. Work presently consists of the design and construction of a new tee and bunker complexes. Robert Trent Jones, Sr. originally designed the course in the 1960s.

Montammy Golf Club – Alpine, New Jersey

Work on this private, 18-hole golf course originally designed by Frank Duane in the 1960's involves renovations to tee and bunker complexes. Several fairway-regrading projects are also being studied.

Mount Anthony Country Club – Bennington, Vermont

RBA Golf is in the process of developing a golf course improvement master plan for MACC, which is thought to be one of the oldest private 18-holes courses in the state. Current course renovations include new tee and bunker complexes. Several options of rerouting holes are also being explored.

The Tuxedo Club – Tuxedo Park, New York

This remodeling project, consisting of an existing 18-hole, private golf course involves updating a Robert Trent Jones, Sr., golf course facility. Tee complexes, bunker complexes, tree management and practice areas are all part of an ongoing course improvement program.

Upper Montclair Country Club – Clifton, New Jersey

This remodeling project, consisting of an existing 27-hole, private golf course involves updating an A.W. Tillinghast/Robert Trent Jones, Sr., golf course facility. Tee complexes, bunker complexes and practice areas are all part of an ongoing course improvement master plan program.

White Beeches Golf & Country Club – Oradell, New Jersey

Work on the golf course originally designed by Walter J. Travis includes preparing a master plan to address fairway and greenside bunkering, tee leveling/expansion, fairway recontouring, tree management, pond work and drainage improvements.
